3. The petitioner has filed the present petition impugning the orders dated 12.07.2016 and 11.11.2016 passed by Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (DUSIB).
4. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent states that the petitioner has an equally efficacious remedy by way of an appeal under Section 45 of the Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board Act, 2010.
