1. 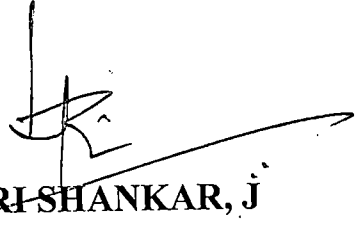
