It is submitted that petitioner (husband) and respondent no.2 (wife) have started living together after settling their disputes amicably, therefore, it is prayed that FIR No. 453/2016 under Sections 323/315 IPC registered at police station Pandav Nagar may be quashed. Respondent no.2 is present in Court and has been identified by SI Mahesh Singh of police station Pandav Nagar. She admits that she has settled the matter with her husband, inasmuch as, is living with him since June, 2018. She further says that she has no objection if FIR and the consequent proceedings are quashed.

Keeping in mind that husband and wife have started living together after ironing out their differences, inasmuch as, wife does not wish to pursue

the FIR, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served in keeping them entangled in the criminal proceedings. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms.
