Respondent no. 2 Ms. Sarabjeet Kaur is present in Court and has been identified by SI Pardeep Singh of police station Mahendra Park. Respondent no. 2 says that she has settled the matter with the petitioner no. 1 of her own free will, voluntarily and without any undue force, pressure or coercion before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre vide a Settlement Agreement dated 13th September, 2017, inasmuch as she has received the entire settlement amount and she has no objection in case FIR is quashed against the petitioner no. 1 and his relatives, that is,

petitioner nos. 2 to 4.

Keeping in view the settlement arrived at between the petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2, in the interest of justice, FIR No.500/2014 under Sections 498-A/406 IPC registered at Police Station Mahendra Park and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.
