The present joint application under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 has been instituted on behalf of the petitioners, as well as, respondent Nos.2 and 3 prays as follows:-

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties, state in unison, that the underlying dispute that led to the institution of the present petition has been amicably settled by and between the parties and the terms and conditions of the settlement are enshrined in the Settlement Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding dated 06.07.2018 and the same is annexed as Annexure-‘A’ to the present application.

The Settlement Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding dated 06.07.2018 entered into between the parties is lawful and the same is hereby accepted and taken on record.

The parties shall abide by the terms and conditions of the said Settlement Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding dated 06.07.2018 without demur.

The application is disposed of accordingly.

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In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, as aforesaid, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.

Leave granted.

The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly. The pending application also stands disposed of.
