II. Pass such other or further order/orders as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case”.

Ms. Arunima Dwivedi, learned standing counsel appearing on behalf of the NCTE/Respondent No. 1 states that, they shall constitute a visiting team to conduct the requisite inspection qua the petitioner institution within six weeks from today, in accordance with law.
