ORDER

The petitioner seeks parole for filing a Special Leave Petition against his conviction and for maintaining social ties with his family members and society. According to the Status Report, the petitioner's address has been verified.

In view of the above, the Court finds no impediment in allowing the present petition. Consequently, the petitioner is granted parole for a period of six weeks from the date of his release on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent concerned subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The petitioner shall report to the SHO, concerned Police Station, Shahdara, once a week on every Tuesday during the period of parole.
- (2) He shall furnish his telephone number to the SHO concerned, which the petitioner shall keep operational at all times

- (3) He shall not leave the territory of NCT of Delhi.
- (4) The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities at the expiry of the period of parole.

A copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the parties. Additionally, a copy of this order shall also be delivered upon the Jail Superintendent concerned through the State.

With the above directions the Writ Petition is disposed-off.
