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By this petition petitioners Ankit Malhotra, Pradeep Kumar Malhotra and Pramod Kumar Malhotra seek quashing of FIR No.316/2016 under sections 323/341/506/427/34 IPC registered at police station Amar Colony on the complaint of Shashikant Talwar and Saroj Talwar, respondent nos. 2 and 3.
