After some arguments, Mr. M. Hasibuddin, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to seek relief, in terms of the orders passed on 20.03.2018, in **SLP (Civil) Diary No(s).5253/2018**, titled as '**Shiv Shankar & Ors. vs. DDA (Delhi Development Authority) Through its Vice Chairman & Anr.**', which is extracted hereinbelow:-
