Though the grounds for absence on 24.07.2018 do not impress for the simple reason the website of the court would indicate the date fixed, having regard to the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, vis-a-vis the main petition, the delay in filing the application for restoration is condoned and the prayer for restoration is allowed.
