This writ petition seeks release of the petitioner on parole for a period of two months because he is indisposed due to ailments related to age; he is over 80 years of age and has a breathing problem and high blood pressure; he is already out on parole and wishes to settle his affairs by partitioning the

sole property. This aspect has already been verified earlier. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's parole is expiring tomorrow i.e. on 18.09.2018.

In the circumstances, the petitioner's parole is extended for a period of seven weeks on the same terms and conditions as enumerated in the order dated 01.08.2018.

With the above directions, the writ petition is disposed-off.
