After some arguments, the learned counsel for the appellant states that without prejudice to his rights and contentions, he would not press the appeal but would request that the Trial Court be directed to expedite the disposal of the suit. The case is at the stage of recording of evidence of the respondent (plaintiff in the suit).

In view of the above, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. The Trial Court is requested to expedite the trial of the suit and endeavour to dispose the suit off depending upon the list of cases before its board, preferably by the end of the year.
