ORDER

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By the present petition the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 36/2016 under Sections 420/406/34 IPC registered at PS Anand Vihar, Delhi on the complaint of Respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that the parties have settled the matter.

Learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that in the above-noted FIR both the petitioners are the only accused and respondent No.2 the only complainant/victim.

Respondent No. 2 is present in Court and is identified by the Investigating Officer. He states that he has settled the matter with the **W.P.(CRL) 2175/2017**

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petitioners vide the memorandum of settlement executed at New Delhi on 18th May, 2017. He states that in lieu of his claims he has already received a sum of ₹4.25 lakhs and the balance amount of ₹75,000/- has been received by him today in Court. He states that now he has no claim whatsoever against the petitioners and would abide by the terms of settlement.

Petitioners are present in Court and are identified by the learned counsel. They affirm the statement of respondent No.2 and undertake to abide by the terms of settlement.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 36/2016 under Sections 420/406/34 IPC registered at PS Anand Vihar, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

Parties have signed this order sheet in acknowledgment of their statements made before this Court.

Petition is disposed of. Order dasti.
