1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a copy of the order dated 11.02.2017 passed by Sh. Tarun Singhal, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Presiding Judge, Lok Adalat, Faridabad, Haryana. Same is taken on record.
