It would be for the learned suit court to consider the application and pass an appropriate order after closing of evidence of PW5 or any other witness of the plaintiff.

Time for keeping the original sale deed dated 28.12.2005 in a sealed cover is extended upto two weeks from today.

With the aforesaid observation, the appeal stands disposed of.
