1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

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2. Issue notice.
3. Mrs. Avnish Ahlawat accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.
4. Mr. Satvik Varma, learned counsel, who, appears on behalf of the petitioner, says that the captioned petition has been moved to seek appointment of an Arbitrator, on account of the demise of the erstwhile Arbitrator i.e. Hon'ble Mr. Justice S. S. Chadha, a former judge of this Court.
5. Mrs. Avnish Ahlawat says that she has no objection to this court

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appointing another Arbitrator in the matter.

9. The learned Arbitrator will file his declaration before entering upon reference in terms of Section 12 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

10. Parties and their counsels will appear before the learned Arbitrator on 31.10.2018 at 4:00 pm.

11. In case the date given by the Court is not convenient to the learned Arbitrator, then, he will fix another date which is proximate to the date given by the Court

12. The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

13. The Registry will dispatch a copy of this order to the learned Arbitrator.
