ORDER

1. By this petition, petitioner seeks parole on the ground that he needs to establish social ties and also challenges the communication dated 14th August, 2018 whereby his application seeking parole to arrange finances for the study of his minor children, that is, son and daughter was dismissed by the competent authority.
