Notice. Learned APP accepts notice for respondent no. 1.
Respondent no.2 Mr. Ashok Kumar Java is present in Court along with his
counsel and accepts notice. He has been identified by SI Ram Naresh of
police station Amar Colony.

Respondent no.2 submits that he has settled the matter with
petitioners of his own free will and without any undue force, pressure or
coercion, vide a Settlement Agreement dated 27th September, 2018.
Respondent no. 2 says that he has no objection in case FIR No. 565/2014
under Sections 380/457 IPC registered at Police Station Amar Colony and

consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no. 2 voluntarily, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.
