ORDER

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31.10.2018

1. Issue notice. The learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice.
2. The petitioner has filed the present petition, *inter alia*, praying that appropriate orders be issued to the respondents for refund of the e-Court fee purchased by the petitioner.
3. It is the petitioner's case that on 07.05.2018, he entered into the transaction for purchase of a immovable property and had also paid ₹10 lakhs as earnest money out of the total consideration of ₹6,66,66,500/- for the same. He applied for e-stamp papers for execution of the title documents, however, it is claimed that by mistake he purchased e-Court fee of a sum of ₹40 lakhs instead of non judicial stamp paper.
4. The petitioner, thereafter, approached the office of the respondent for refund of the e-Court fee. However, the said request has not been entertained.

5. In view of the above, the respondent is directed to refund the e-Court fee purchased by the petitioner, on the petitioner taking necessary steps to surrender the e-Court fee, if not, already done.
6. The petition is disposed of.
