Respondent nos.2 to 5 are present in Court and accepts notice. They have
been identified by SI Talib Khan of police station Neb Sarai.

Respondent nos.2 to 5 submits that they have settled the matter with
the petitioners of their own free will and without any undue force, pressure
or coercion. Respondent nos. 2 to 5 says that they have no objection in case
FIR No.333/2017, under Sections 308/427/34 IPC, police station-Neb Sarai
is quashed against the petitioners.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and
