This petition seeks quashing of FIR. The Court would note that the FIR is registered under sections 307/34 IPC & 27/54/59 Arms Act. Gun shots were allegedly fired by petitioner. It is a serious matter which has severe consequences towards law and order and also creates a sense of fear in society.

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Mr. Rajesh Mahajan, the learned ASC for the State relies upon the judgment of the Supreme Court in *State of Madhya Pradesh v. Manish and Others* (2015) 3 SCC (Cri.) 510.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for cancellation of the FIR. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed accordingly.
