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2 Issue notice.

2.1 Mr. Gopal Singh accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Learned counsel says that he does not wish to file a reply as he does not oppose the prayer made for extension of time.

3 The record shows that the Arbitral Tribunal entered upon reference on 02.06.2017. The record also shows that this Court, vide order dated 22.05.2018, passed in OMP (MISC.) (COMM) No.102/2018, extended time by another six months beyond the statutory period of 12 months. This period was, however, extended w.e.f. 01.06.2018.

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4 I am informed by the learned counsel for the parties that the matter is at the stage of arguments.

5 Accordingly, having regard to the time and money invested by the parties, I am inclined to extend the time for concluding the arbitration proceedings by another four months, commencing from 30.11.2018. It is ordered accordingly.

6 Petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
