1. This is a petition filed under Section 14 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
2. The prayer made in the petition, in effect, is that the mandate of Mr. K.K. Gupta, who, stands appointed as the Arbitrator in the matter be terminated.
3. On the previous date, Mr. Kirtiman Singh, learned counsel for the respondent, had suggested alternate names.
