Notice. Learned APP accepts notice for respondent no.1. Respondent no.2 is present in Court and has been identified by SI Rajender Singh of police station Malviya Nagar.

Respondent no.2 submits that she has settled the matter with petitioners of her own free will and without any undue force, pressure or coercion before the Delhi Mediation Centre, Saket Court, New Delhi on 2nd June, 2017. She has no objection in case FIR No. 353/2014 under Sections 420/468/471/34 IPC registered at police station Malviya Nagar is quashed.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2 voluntarily, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be

served in keeping the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed. Affidavit of respondent no.2 to this effect is on record.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms.
