2. This is a joint petition seeking extension of time.

3. The record shows that the learned Arbitrator was appointed by this Court vide order dated 24.11.2016, passed in OMP (I) (COMM) 419/2016.

4. The record also shows that learned Arbitrator accepted the appointment on 28.11.2016.

5. Evidently, with the consent of parties, the learned Arbitrator extended the statutory period of twelve (12) months by another six (6) months having regard to the complexity of the matter.

6. The extended time frame has already come to an end i.e. on 28.11.2018.
