1. The petitioners seek regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.548/2016 under Sections 452/506/34/120B/436/323/448 IPC registered at Police Station Burari. Status report is on record.

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have examined the file. The petitioners are in custody since 27.10.2016. Charge-sheet has since been filed and many prosecution witnesses have been examined. The victim suffered injuries 'simple' in nature.
3.
