ORDER

Respondent no.2 Ms. Rakhi Kohli is present in Court along with her counsel and accepts notice.

Respondent no. 2 submits that she has settled the matter with petitioner no. 1 amicably before the Counselling Cell, Family Courts, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi of her own free will and without any undue force, pressure or coercion. Respondent no. 2 further submits that her marriage with petitioner no. 1 has already been dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent dated 7th October, 2017 passed by the Family Courts, South – West District, Dwarka, New Delhi. She says that terms of the settlement

have been complied with and she has no objection in case FIR no. 872/2014 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Binda Pur and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed against the petitioner no. 1 and his relatives, i.e., petitioner nos. 2 to 9.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no. 2 voluntarily, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
