Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition as they have filed an appeal before the Municipal Taxation Tribunal ('Tribunal' for short). She submits that withdrawal of the present petition should not be treated as an adverse order or finding and all issues it should be clarified are left open.
