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Quashing of FIR No. 168/2018 under Section 498-A/406/34 registered at police station Rajouri Garden, Delhi on the charge-sheet filed in this case is sought on the ground of territorial jurisdiction and on merits also.

It is stated that the charge-sheet in this case has been filed and matter is coming up before the trial court on the point of charge on 23rd January, 2019.
