The apology offered by the defendant no.4 Mr. Kumar Vishwas is accepted by this Court and a decree is passed, in favour of the plaintiff and against the defendant no.4 Mr. Kumar Vishwas in terms of his letter handed over today in the Court and on which, for the sake of identification, Ex.D-4 is put in today's date and leaving the plaintiff and the defendant no.4 Mr. Kumar Vishwas to bear their own costs.
5. Decree sheet be drawn up.
6. Ex.D-4 to form part of decree sheet.
7. The suit, insofar as against the other defendants, was already decreed on 3rd April, 2018 and is now disposed of.
