ORAL ORDER

2 28-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 365, 366 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the statement of the victim-girl recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. that she was willing to be with co-accused Niranjana Yadav, a Coordinate Bench has already granted anticipatory bail to Niranjana Yadav vide order dated 03.07.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 33155 of 2018. Petitioner was associate of Niranjana Yadav at the time of kidnapping.

Hence, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Neemchak Bathani Police Station Case No. 68 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
