3 22-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Section 366(A) of the Indian Penal
Code.

Seven FIR named accused persons initially
pressurized the informant to marry his daughter with the
referred person. On refusal of the informant they kidnapped her.
The statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 164
Cr.P.C. reveals that this petitioner who is aged about 66 had
kidnapped on motorcycle and got her married with Siyalal
Sahani. However, Siyalal Sahani did not do anything to her.

Considering the statement of the victim girl as well
as age of the petitioner who has got no criminal antecedent, let



the petitioner who is in custody since 16.11.2018, above named,
be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/-
(Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to
the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is
pending in connection with Paroo P.S. Case No. 202 of 2015,
S.Tr. No. 54 of 2016, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial
jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the
investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below
shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
