This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Buxar Mufassil Police Station Case No. 284 of 2018, disclosing offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act').

There being bar under Section 76 (2) of the Act, this anticipatory bail application cannot be maintained and is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, considering the nature of allegation in the First Information Report, it is directed that if the petitioner surrenders before the Court below within four weeks from today and applies for regular bail, his application shall be considered



without being prejudiced by the present order of dismissal.
