The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Jagdishpur P.S.Case No.309 of 2018 dated 12.8.2018 registered in Excise Case No.1288 of 2018 registered for offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is about recovery of 40 lts. of liquor from the market,his name transpired in the FIR and he succeeded in fleeing away. It further appears that the petitioner is accused in one more case.
