ORAL ORDER

2 20-06-2019 The present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to grant the benefits of first and second ACP to the petitioner herein.

The learned counsel for the respondents, referring to the counter affidavit, filed by the respondents, submits that the District Welfare Officer, Katihar has already sent recommendation for the purposes of grant of the aforesaid benefits to the petitioner by a letter dated 10.07.2018 and now it is for the Director, Welfare Department, Government of Bihar, Patna to take a final call in the matter.
