learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Nokha P.S. Case No. 82
of 2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s)
147/148/149/448/341/323/324/325/307/302 of the Indian Penal
Code.

In the written report, it is alleged that on the date of
occurrence this petitioner and other accused persons assaulted
the husband and other family members of the informant. There
is specific allegation against this petitioner of assaulting the
husband of informant with *Garasa*, on account of, which he fell
down and died on the spot.

Case diary has been received, wherein, the
postmortem report is available.



The doctor, in the postmortem report, has found skull bone frontal and occipital and parietal bone fracture in multiple pieces and brain substance and meninges were lacerated and due to aforesaid injury husband of the informant died. There is specific allegation against this petitioner of assaulting the husband of the informant with *Garsa*. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. The prayer for bail of the petitioner stands rejected.

Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and make efforts to conclude the same as early as possible preferably within a period of one year from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Petitioner may renew his prayer for bail in the event trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period.
