4 26-03-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in

connection with Complaint Case No. 2016C of 2015, disclosing

offences under Sections 379 and 498(A) of the Indian Penal

Code.

Case is under Section 498(A) of the Indian Penal
Code and allegation against the petitioner is of subjecting his
wife to cruelty with respect to demand of dowry.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that he is still ready to keep her.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the
opposite party no.2, they have submit that the complainant is
also ready to live with the petitioner, if the petitioner assures her



to keep her with dignity and care.

Having heard both sides, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the court below on 11.04.2019 and file a petition that he is ready to keep the complainant with dignity and care and the opposite party no.2 shall also remain present on that day and the petitioner shall take her to his father's house on that day itself and on such, the provisional bail earlier granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.01.2019 shall continue for six months and during that period the learned court below will watch the conduct of both the parties by calling them in the first week of each month and once the learned court below is satisfied with the conduct of both the parties, he shall confirm the provisional bail of the petitioner otherwise, he is free to pass any order or orders as he deems fit and proper.

Accordingly, this application is disposed of.
