Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of
Birupur P.S. Case No. 6 of 2018 for the offence under Sections
394 and 412 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the seriousness of the offence, I am not
inclined to grant the petitioner privilege of anticipatory bail.
This application is dismissed.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the
Court below within a period of four weeks from today and seek
regular bail, if so advised. If he does so, his application for
regular bail shall be considered by the learned Court below on
its own merit without being prejudiced by rejection of present
application for grant of anticipatory bail.
