counsel for the informant as well as learned Additional Public
Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 302, 201, 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner happens to be wife of step-brother of the
deceased and prosecution claimed that petitioner along with her
sons eliminated the deceased with an object to grab the entire
ancestral property. However, it appears that except suspicion,
there is nothing against the petitioner. Moreover, the
investigation against the petitioner has already been completed.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as



well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bagaha, West Champaran in connection with Bagaha P.S. Case No. 518 of 2018.
