2 13-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents.

The present application has been filed for modification of order dated 20.11.2017 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 23467 of 2011 by which the writ petition was disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority against the order dated 20.10.2011 passed by the Member, District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority, Bhojpur, within a period of thirty days from the date



of order i.e. 20.11.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable reasons, she could not prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority. Hence, she prays for further thirty days time to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority.

Considering the grounds mentioned in the application, the petitioner is granted further thirty days time to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority from today.

The order dated 20.11.2017 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 23467 of 2011 stands modified to the extent as indicated above.

The modification application is, accordingly, allowed.
