ORAL ORDER

2 17-01-2019 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as
well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 394/302 and 414 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is not named in the first information
report but in course of investigation the name of petitioner's
husband as well as others surfaced in this case and it also came
to light that the husband of the petitioner and others committed
the loot and, thereafter, murdered the truck driver. The looted
TMT *sariya* was recovered near the house of petitioner and the
looted truck was on N.H. 102. So far as the petitioner is
concerned, one police official claimed that she had taken part in
concealing the looted truck.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III West, Muzaffarpur in connection with Kudhani P.S. Case No. 418/2018.
