2 25-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending her arrest in connection with Vaishali (Belsur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 220 of 2018 registered for offences under sections 341, 323, 324, 307 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

During investigation, it has been found that the petitioner has assaulted by Khurpi on the shoulder of the Informant.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, namely, Kanti Devi, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like



amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Vaishali (Belsur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 220 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. as also subject to condition that whenever the police will call the petitioner for investigation/interrogation, she will remain present and if she would not present herself, the privilege of grant of anticipatory bail shall be deemed to have been canceled.
