counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with Mehsi P.S.
Case No. 20 of 2018 for the offence under sections 379, 420 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He is in custody since
23.10.2018.

Learned counsel further submits that petitioner was
not named in the FIR and nothing incriminating was recovered
from the conscious or constructive possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel submits that he was not even put on
TIP.
