It appears that in paragraph no.4 of the order dated 15.01.2019, it has been recorded that ‘petitioners are neither the owner nor the driver of the tractors’, though, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are the owner and driver, respectively, of one of the seized tractors and statement to that effect has also been made in the petition.
