ORAL ORDER

4 22-04-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises

out of Complaint Case No. C-62/2018, disclosing offences

under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4

of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the complainant
and allegation against him is of subjecting the complainant to
cruelty in connection with demand of motorcycle as dowry.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that all the allegations are false and concocted. However, he is
still ready to keep the complainant with full honour and dignity
and since the petitioner is a handicapped persons, the
complainant herself does not want to reside with the petitioner



and making such false allegations.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the complainant. Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the complainant is also ready to live with the petitioner, if she is kept with full honour and dignity as a wife.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of with direction to the petitioner and the complainant to appear before the concerned court below on 09.05.2019 and if the petitioner files a petition that he is ready to keep the complainant with himself with full honour and dignity and he is willing to take the complainant with himself from the court itself and the complainant- opposite party no.2 shall also file an affidavit that she is also ready to live with the petitioner and has no pre-condition, the court below shall release the petitioner on provisional bail for a period of six months to his own satisfaction and in the meantime, the court below will watch the conduct of the parties by calling the complainant and petitioner in the first week of each month for a period of six months and after six months, if the court below is satisfied with the conduct of the petitioner, he will confirm the provisional bail of the petitioner otherwise, he will free to pass any order including



cancellation of provisional bail of the petitioner.

With the above observation, this application is
disposed of
