In the instant application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the prayer of the petitioner in para 1 is as under:-

(A) A writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ/s, order/s, direction/s commanding the Respondents Authorities:-

(i) To investigate the case concerned, i.e. Chiraiya P.S. Case No.211 of 2015 on the point of involvement of the accused persons namely Randhir Yadav, Rajesh Yadav, Rampravesh Yadav and Tarun Mishra in the alleged acts, so as to help strengthen the prosecution's case to meet the ends of justice.



(ii) To submit appropriate documents concerned with the aforementioned investigation, with the court concerned.

(B) To any other relief/s to which the petitioner is found entitled to.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that due to efflux of time, the application has become infructuous.

In view of the submission made above, the application is dismissed.
