Main contention of learned counsel for the petitioner  
is that without considering the injury report learned Sessions  
Judge has granted bail to opposite party No.2 though it is a case  
under Section 307 IPC.

Heard learned APP and perused the impugned order  
from which it appears that learned court below has considered  
the case and granted bail to opposite party No.2 on merit  
considering that no injury report has been produced by  
prosecution. In such view of the matter, I am not inclined to



interfere with the impugned order pass by learned
