petitioner, was to be left for passage in terms of the recitals in

Upon carefully going through the pleadings in the writ
petition and the documents annexed in support of the averments,
I am of the view that the petitioner is raising a civil dispute
between her and the private respondents in a proceeding under
Article 226 of the Constitution of India, which cannot be
maintained.



This application is dismissed for the said reason.

The petitioner shall have the liberty to approach competent court of civil jurisdiction, or any other forum, if permissible, for adjudication of his dispute, in accordance with law.
