2 15-01-2019 The present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner on compassionate ground in place of her husband who died in harness on 12.12.2015.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that despite the petitioner having filed appropriate application before the respondent no. 4 on 12.05.2017, no action has been



taken for appointing the petitioner on compassionate ground,
hence the respondents be directed to do the needful.

case, the Chairman of Bihar State Madarsa Education Board,
Patna i.e. the respondent no. 3 is directed to consider the case of
the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground and
pass a final order within a period of 12 weeks from today.
