2 23-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No. 445 of 2018 for the offence 30 (a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. He further submits that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. From the seizure list it would appear that 4796 bottle English Wine was recovered from the Bolero Vehicle. He further submits that petitioners have no concern with recovered foreign liquor at all.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have no



criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 02.12.2018, let the petitioners, named above are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 3rd Addl. Sessions Judge Cum Spl. Judge Excise Samastipur in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No. 445 of 2018 subject to the conditions that for each petitioner one of the bailor should be elected representative of the local body.
